After Tour

Brief Itinerary / Route

Day 1

At the conclusion of the National Weekend Lunch we will be driving to Clevedon, then following the Seabird Coast and joining SHW25 at Waitakaruru. From here we will drive onto Whangamata for our Monday night stopover. Dinner has been arranged for the group here.

Day 2

Tuesday morning depart Whangamata to Waihi on SHW25.

(For those that are interested we have arranged a 30 minute Gold Discovery Experience at the Waihi Gold Discovery Centre at 10.00am in the Waihi township. This comes highly recommended and is well worth the visit to find out the fascinating history of this area during the days of the gold rush.)

Depart Waihi on SHW2 via the Karangahake Gorge, where there are further gold mining sites that can be explored, then to Paeroa.

Leaving Paeroa follow SHW26 to Te Aroha, then driving the Old Te Aroha Rd on the western side of the Kaimai Ranges until the intersection with SHW24. Then over the Kaimai Ranges on SHW29 to our next night stopover in Tauranga. Own arrangements for this nights dinner.

Day 3

Wednesday morning depart Tauranga and over to the airport to visit the Classic Flyers Warbirds Museum for a tour at approx. 10.00 am. Those not wishing to visit the museum can spend the morning discovering Tauranga, Mt Maunganui and the beach. Then down the coast on SHW2 to our overnight stop in Whakatane. Own arrangements for this nights dinner but suggest The Comm Pub, home of Good George Brewing, which is attached to our accommodation.

Day 4

Thursday morning depart Whakatane for Taupo using the roads less travelled, passing over the Te Mahoe Hydro Dam, Omataroa, Waiohau, Galatea then joining SHW38 to SHW5, then the back road via Broadlands to Taupo for our final nights stopover. Group Dinner booked here for our last night.
